



SAN ROMÁN 2005

Alcohol: 14.5 °

Grape varieties: Tinta de Toro 100%

Production: 87.000 bottles y 1.800 magnums

Vineyards: San Román de Hornija- Villaester

Soils: Stony & sandy-clay



Continental vintage with early harvest by 2 weeks, yield was reduced by 30% due to drought. Ripening was slower and more complete on the older vines and the vineyards planted in cool areas at a higher altitude.

Magnificent pureness of fruit with vibrant floral aromas and fine earthy base/background. Long and silky, full bodied and dense on the palate but never heavy. Abundant but polished tannins. Distinguished.

Bottled in April 2008 after spending 23 months in new and semi-new French and American oak.
