A rainy and cold spring until May delayed the sprouting of the vines which later accelerated their development due to a very hot and dry summer. Luckily, the water reserves in the soil allowed the plant to withstand the water deficit well. The harvest began on 9th September with moderate alcohol content. Temperatures were falling as the days passed in a more extensive than usual period of gradual collection that ended on 12th October.

Of higher yields than in the previous harvests, the resulting wines from this vintage are characterized by their accessibility, bright fruitiness and polished tannins. The finest Prima to date.
